While the programs both work to benefit Norton Children's Hospital, they each have their own programming, requirements and expectations.

This program includes volunteer opportunities at popular Norton Children's Hospital Foundation events and encourages individual impact through fundraising. Teen Ambassadors is a great stepping stone to becoming a Teen Board member if desired.

Rising 11th and 12th graders have the choice to continue or begin involvement with the Teen Ambassadors or choose to increase their commitment level and impact by becoming a Norton Children's Hospital Teen Board member. Board Members meet monthly to learn more about roles within and those that support Norton Children's Hospital and participate in various personal development programming. Additionally, the Teen Board has volunteer opportunities and fundraising requirements that support the Norton Children's Hospital Foundation.

Teen Ambassador Expectations

- Rising 9th 12th grade students in the Louisville or Southern Indiana region.
- Attend a mandatory orientation session in August.
- Attend all scheduled meetings.
- Each member must volunteer at two (2) Norton Children's Hospital, Teen Board, or Norton Children's Hospital Foundation events.
- Treat all volunteers, patients, families and fellow ambassadors/board members with respect and generosity.
- Be an outstanding representative of the Foundation at all events and volunteer opportunities
- Be a champion for fundraising for Norton Children's Hospital in your high school or other groups you are involved in.
- Raise funds for Norton Children's Hospital and think outside the box for fundraising idea.

Teen Board Expectations

- Rising 11th 12th grade students in the Louisville or Southern Indiana region.
- Attend a mandatory orientation session in August.
- Attend all scheduled meetings. (Max one meeting per month)
- Each member must volunteer for a minimum of eight (8) hours each semester (16 hours for the year) with Norton Children's Hospital, Teen Board, or Norton Children's Hospital Foundation events.
 - o If you exceed 8 hours in the fall semester, those hours will roll-over into the spring.
- Treat all volunteers, patients, families and fellow ambassadors/board members with respect and generosity.
- Be an outstanding representative of the Foundation at all events and volunteer opportunities
- Be a champion for fundraising for Norton Children's Hospital in your high school or other groups you are involved in.
- Raise funds for Norton Children's Hospital and think outside the box for fundraising idea.
