## Teen Ambassadors Expectations 2024-2025

The Norton Children's Hospital Foundation Teen Board and Teen Ambassador Programs are fun organizations that meet to share ideas and help the kids at Norton Children's Hospital through fundraising, events, volunteering and special projects.

The Teen Ambassador program is exclusive to high school students in the Louisville and Southern Indiana area. To participate in Teen Ambassadors you must be a current or rising 9th to 12th grader. The Teen Ambassadors meet less frequently than Teen Board, up to five times per school year. The Teen Ambassadors support Teen Board initiatives, volunteer at Norton Children's Hospital Foundation events and fundraise. This program is a great stepping stone for those interested in Teen Board and other Norton Children's Hospital involvement. We look forward to reviewing your application!

- Attend the mandatory orientation session in August.
- Attend all scheduled meetings. Date and time of scheduled meetings will be determined after the group is selected. Meetings will be after school on either Monday or Wednesday evenings.
  - If an absence is necessary, please notify Toree Parrish by email at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting.
  - If two or more meetings are missed without notification, you may be up for dismissal from the Teen Ambassadors.
- Each member of the Teen Ambassadors must volunteer at **two** Norton Children's Hospital, Teen Board, or Children's Hospital Foundation event **per school year**.
- Treat all volunteers, patients, families, and fellow board members/ambassadors with respect and generosity.
- Be an outstanding representative of the Foundation at all events and volunteer opportunities by listening to directions, problem solving, and offering help in all areas when needed.
- Make the most of teen ambassadors by being present and engaging in discussion during meetings and events. Refrain from being distracted or being a distraction to others (i.e. texting or using your cell phone). Ask thoughtful questions.
- Be a champion for fundraising for Norton Children's Hospital in your school, your community, and/or other groups you are involved in.
- Raise funds for Norton Children's Hospital and think outside the box for fundraising ideas.
