DESIGNER TIPS AND IDEAS

Follow these tips to design an item that is both beautiful and unique.

Our best-selling items usually include:

- Classic Christmas colors, themes and decorations
- Simple ornaments that vary in size, scale and shape
- Ribbon, garland or sprays that help fill holes between branches
- A unique tree skirt or base such as a decorative box, galvanized bucket, wheelbarrow, wagon or sleigh

Other successful trees have featured:

- Toys for children or gifts
- Gift certificates or usable items
- Additional lights or colored lights
- Elements from nature, such as wood, birds or flowers
- A surprising twist on a holiday classic, such as a tree that looks like a snowman or a wreath with vintage ice skates

Find your number

Strike a balance between bare branches and ornament overload by using the chart below as a guide. Oversized ball ornaments add color and shine while lighting up darker pockets in your tree or wreath. Cluster smaller ornaments together for greater impact.

Tree height	Number of decorations
2 feet	25 to 35
3 feet	35 to 50
4 feet	50 to 75
7.5 feet	175 to 275
