To give kids a fighting chance

More than **10,000** infants and children up to age 14 will be diagnosed with cancer in 2017.

An estimated **1,190** children in the U.S. will not survive cancer this year.

Cancer is the **second-leading cause** of death in children ages 1 to 14 (exceeded only by accidents).

To help families in our community

At Norton Children's Cancer Institute, **150+** children have been diagnosed with pediatric cancer in the past two years.

In 2016, there were **600** admissions for cancer at Norton Children's Hospital and 6,700 cancer outpatient visits.

The average cost of a hospital stay for a child with cancer is \$40,000. That's almost **5 times** as much as hospitalizations for other pediatric conditions.

To make a huge impact
